For this structure, listed on the National Register of Historic Buildings and having been the launching point for the ministry and work of the Reverend Doctor Martin Luther King, Jr., team was required to develop design in keeping with requirements of Historical guidelines to preserve aesthetic integrity; design subjected to review and received approval of same. Existing 70-year old terne metal roof system, having been covered over decades with ordinary latex paint and multiple sealants, was cleaned/scraped and power-washed; followed by application of metal primer, elastomeric buff base coat and pigmented finish coat to match original color identified in Historical archive files. Use of telescopic/motorized work platforms utilized in crowded, heavily-trafficked urban location. 
